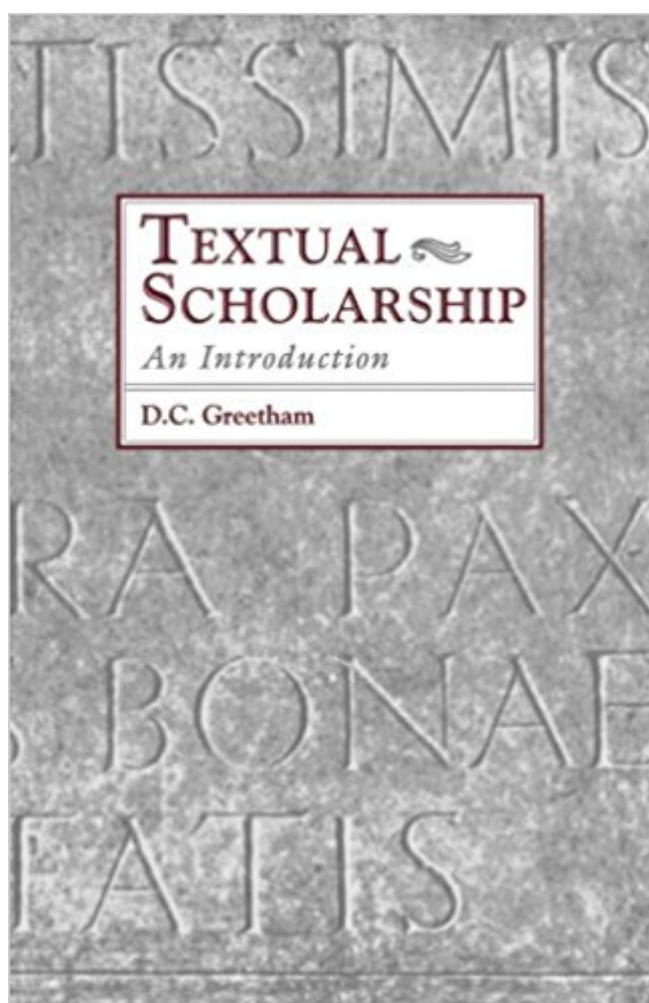

What specifically should a reader expect to gain from consulting this book? An awareness of the process of textual scholarship; An ability to recognize in practice the major classes of identification described throughout the book; A familiarity with the basic vocabulary of textual scholarship and a sense of the appropriate domain of each of the skills represented by the terms; and finally through the active reading and criticism of textual editions and an understanding of the principles whereon they are constructed.

This is an extremely interesting book. I originally bought this for a seminar class and still have it. I loved the history of how books were first made.

Some of the information in it is a little dated, but it has very helpful and informative subject matter.

I returned this book because the class I ordered didn't meet, but I was impressed with the quality. I will use this seller again.

For those of us who have witnessed Professor Greetham at one of his "postmodern" lectures (such as this year at Kalamazoo), this book is a positive surprise. It is just a solid reference work which covers all the aspects of textual scholarship concisely and reliably, albeit often quite briefly. The volume includes a good, extensive bibliography.
