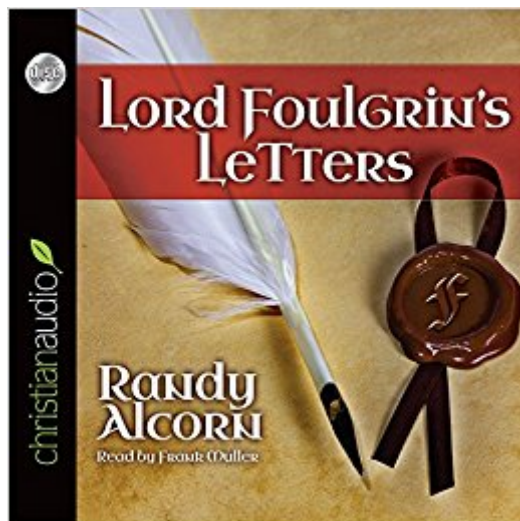


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Lord Foulgrin's Letters

Hard on the heels of Don Hawkins's flambeau@darkcorp.com (LJ 2/1/00), where a demon offers advice to his subordinate via e-mail, Alcorn's repetitious and wordy new work (after Dominion and Deadline) offers homage to C.S. Lewis's The Screwtape Letters. As Foulgrin writes missives to his lackey Squaltaint, he comments on Jordan Fletcher, a businessman so busy looking for happiness that it's passing him by. Fletcher's story unfolds in tiny vignettes between letters as Squaltaint tries to follow his superior's order to corrupt Fletcher so that he will never have a chance at Heaven. While Foulgrin's signatory phrases are somewhat amusing ("The Devil's advocate," "Populating hell one image-bearer at a time," etc.), the basic message behind this book is beaten into the dust.

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This book amazed me. It is disturbing to see how demons work in someone's life. It is even more astounding because I know that this version is a cleaner representation of their deeds too, but even though it is cleaner, its impact is heavy and life altering if you let it be. It is convenient to consider demons as inactive spirits whose presence make you do bad things, but it is another thought altogether to consider them smart, calculating, sinister spirits who try to thwart your attempts to live a Godly life at every single turn. The book also pokes salt into the open wounds of the careless, stunted Christian who has considered himself "okay" in the spiritual warfare department (and yes, that means me). There were times where I found it extremely difficult to read this book. I thought of a thousand different things I could/should/would be doing (including reading the entire Hunger Games trilogy instead), and suddenly reading/finishing this book was not as important. It was interesting and terrifying to compare the book's letters and some of the temptations I've been struggling with recently, seeing how real these demonic influences were in real life as compared to the book freaked me out on more than one occasion. Alcorn did an excellent job peeking into the demonic mind and showing us how the cogs fit together. It is not Lewis' Screwtape Letters and never could be (the author even mentions that), but it is a great rendition or installment into this style literature. I encourage more, properly influenced books of this nature to come into existence at any time!Overall: It was an excellent read that most any true Christian could benefit from reading! Definitely check it out! Great for readers in their teens and beyond!
