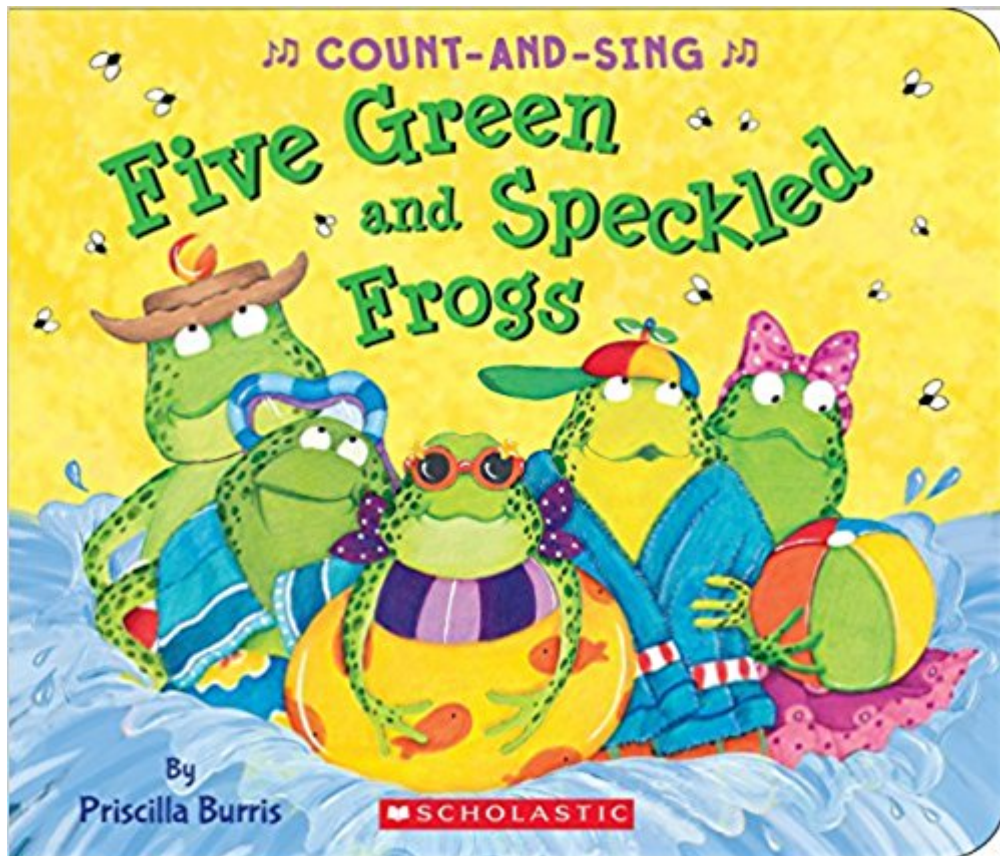

PreSchool-This cheerful version of a familiar song never quite adds up to anything really new or special. The book features silvery, metallic holographic spots … la Marcus Pfister's "Rainbow Fish" books (North-South). The sparkles will likely appeal to young listeners, as will the smiling, decidedly anthropomorphic frogs toggled out in brightly colored bathing suits. But unless the adults reading the book already know the tune, they won't be able to "sing aloud" as the music is not included. Slight variations in the text may present additional barriers to potential singers. The usual refrain ("Yum, yum") has been replaced with phrases matched to the decreasing number of frogs (from "Yum Yum Yum Yum Yum" to "Gulp"). This changes the familiar rhythm, as does the final line,

which also has been altered. The book is visually engaging. Star sunglasses, a perky pink bow, and other accessories allow listeners to differentiate among the frogs as they snack and swim. The final visual joke is the revelation that the cool blue water into which these frogs have been happily jumping is actually a wading pool. The sunny, summery appeal of Burris's illustrations may allow these five frogs to find a place in some collections, but most won't be missing much if they choose to skip this outing. This review is for the BOARD BOOK VERSION. This was one of my son's favorite rhymes. The 'Look inside' the book is totally misleading as that is for the hard cover version and I ordered the book based on that mainly for those illustrations. The board book version is too short/condensed and cut down and do not have the opening pages that offer the detailing in the illustrations that the peek into the book offers from the hard cover version. You expect the board book version to be slightly shorter and concise than the hard cover one yes, but this is just too much condensed that the whole fun and frolic in the original illustrations is lost! This board book version lacks a continuous flow and looks incomplete on the whole. This board book version may have some thing to interest very young toddlers of 1-2 yrs but I do not think this book has any thing to offer to children of 2 and above.
