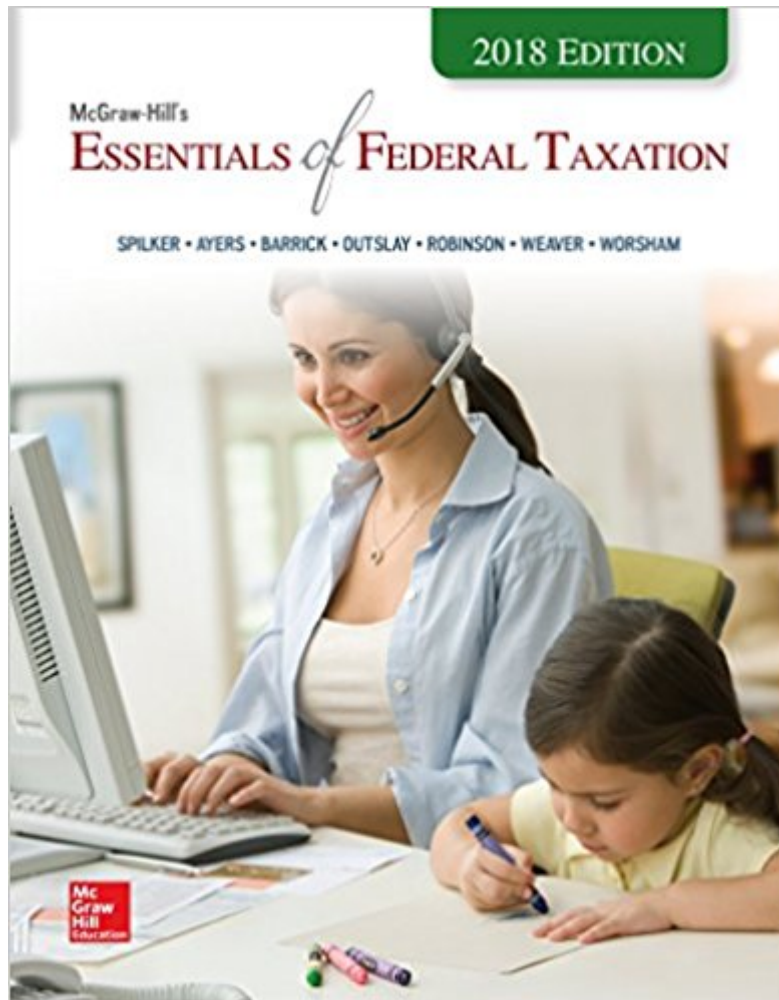


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McGraw-Hill's Essentials Of Federal Taxation 2018 Edition
