This was a syllabus requirement for my project management class and I greatly appreciated my teacher for using this book. This book is filled with examples, highlights of project management, well discussed chapters on the subject matter of project management, as well as a CD with Project 2007 on it. That cd saved me money as I could not afford the actual Project 2007 license at that time. The book had a temporary license and we as students could extend that license after class use. This book was well illustrated and I still have it on my shelf as a reference book. I highly recommend this book for project managers or those who inspire to be.

Chapter Exercises and Appendix Project cases are too many and poorly designed; ambiguous and at best, the examples are not congruent with related chapter exercises. In short, much to my disappointment, most of the exercises and answers did very little in adding to my understanding and application of principles and practices of Project Management. At the expense of good instruction, the text is heavily invested in review and exercise questions than illustrative step by step instructions on how to master for example, project task input, scheduling and designing charts.

I rented this book for class and eventually bought it for future reference. Larson breaks everything down and simplifies the processes that a successful project manager needs to know. He also gives a ton of case studies that help link the theory to practice. The cd that comes with the text is

essentially irrelevant because you can go to Microsoft's site to download your 60 day free trial, of the newest version (Currently 2013).

Great introduction in to the discipline of project management. The concepts and principles presented are readily applicable to any business setting. The accompanying Student CD was a bust but the same information is available online through the publisher's website. The supplemental quizzes are also fantastic to measure concept mastery. MS could be a little more generous than the 90 days free trial; with a 12-week course your professor has to time the initiation of the software so that it meets the needs of the class.
