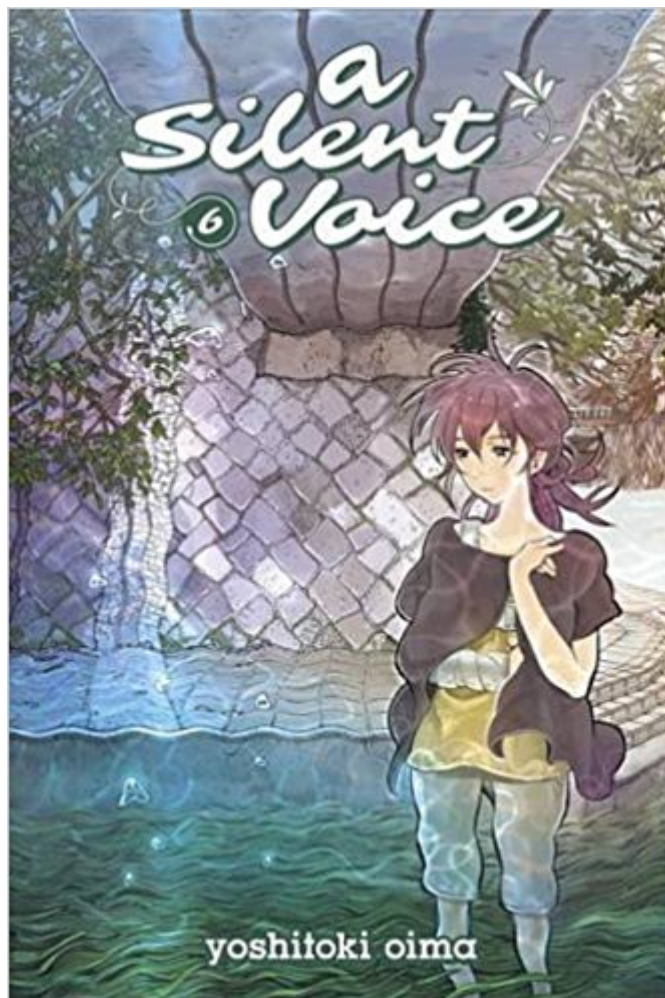


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A Silent Voice 6

Firstly, for anyone that cares, the book was in perfect condition, so you don't have to worry about damage. In this volume, for lack of a better expression, our main character is "out of it". So instead, master storyteller Oima takes to using the other characters and telling the story from their own perspective. It gives that extra piece of understanding to this dramatic and heart-felt story. Not much really happens in this volume, instead a lot of character building happens and it's actually my favorite volume so far. Art is still superb. If you've been following A Silent Voice so far, don't stop now -- it only gets better. If you want to know if this series is worth your time, absolutely. Go pick up the first volume right now. (Next volume is the last, so sad! Also, get hyped for the KyoAni adaptation this fall!)

A manga series worth reading over and over. Soon after what happened in the fifth volume, many of the characters start to self reflect about their own choices that started the whole chain of events that led up to this point. A very deep in thought manga that makes you question the choices you've

made in the foolishness and arrogance of youth.

Events that began at the end of the last volume are concluded early in this one. One character is left shattered in body, another in spirit, and their families and friends struggle to understand what to do now. Up to this point, the story has been told mostly from Shoya's view, focusing on how he interacts with the people around him and they to him. With him being out of commission, the focus is put on others, and the results are intriguing. Some of the others react to the disaster in very extreme ways, others in calmer ways. This volume ends with two of the better chapters of the story up to this point, as we finally see things from Shoko's eyes.

I've done my best to keep this a spoiler-free, short review -- the equivalent of the blurb on a book's back cover. *A Silent Voice* is the translation of the Japanese manga series *Koe no Katachi* (romaji: Koe no Katachi). The subject matter involves a deaf student, and some idiosyncrasies used to convey deaf communication translated extremely well to English written text. At some points it is as if you can hear what deaf people experience. You don't need to like manga to appreciate *A Silent Voice*, but you do need to read the books in order. You can expect romantic tension and strong emotional connections with the characters. The story concerns a protagonist who made some poor decisions as a child (what child doesn't make poor decisions?) that had repercussions, even if he doesn't fully realize their weight. If you decide to give it a shot, you'll be glad you checked it out, and sad when it's over.
