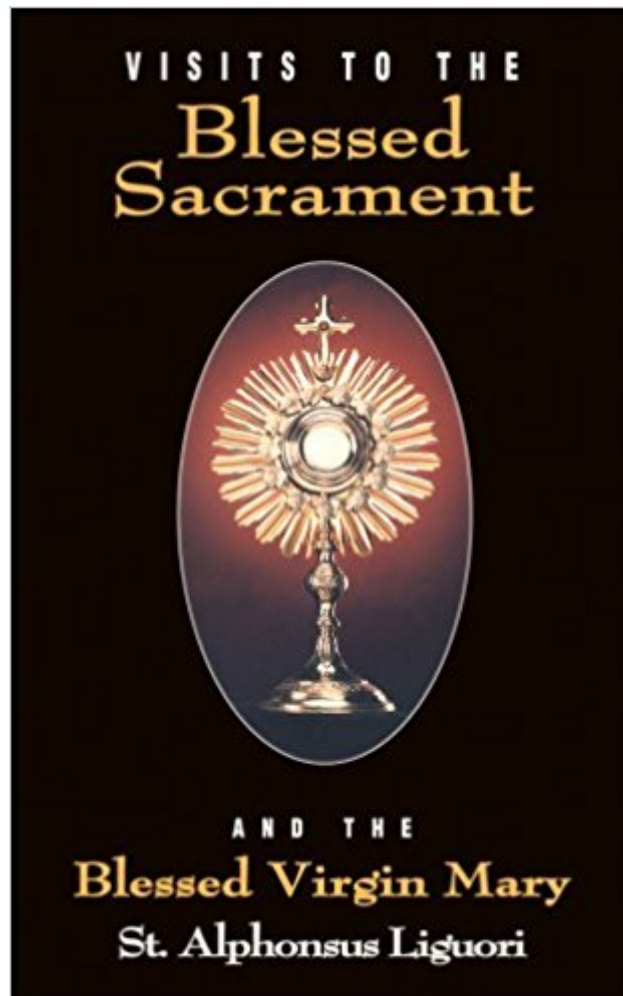

St. Alphonsus Liguori was born in 1696 to Neapolitan nobility at Marianella, Italy. He became a recognizable lawyer after going through law school at the age of sixteen, but later decided to leave law in favor of giving his salvation more attention. Alphonsus joined the Oratory of St. Philip Neri as a seminarian and was ordained in 1726, when he was thirty. The homilies he gave had the special ability of converting those who had fallen away from the faith. He also founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer, and authored such works as *The Glories of Mary*, *The True Spouse of Jesus Christ*, *Attaining Salvation*, *The Blessed Virgin Mary*, *Preparation for Death Abridged*, *What Will Hell Be Like?*, *The Twelve Steps to Holiness and Salvation*, and *The Way of the Cross*. After being a bishop for over a decade, St. Alphonsus Liguori died on the first of August, 1787. He was canonized by Pope Gregory XVI in 1839, and declared a Doctor of the Church in 1871. His feast is celebrated on August 1.

I did not think that I would like this book because St Alphonsus Liguori's books are very difficult to read. I love it. I went to daily Mass for over 20 years and now I am a shut-in. There is a section in this book for people like me who long for and hunger for the Eucharist but are unable to get out of the house.

To repeat myself again and again, anything written by St Alphonsus Liguori is remarkable and outstanding. He is, after all, a Saint and a Doctor of the Catholic Church. This small booklet is quite extraordinary and very well written and a must have companion for visits to the Blessed Sacrament. I also thought so much of this booklet that I bought several more copies to hand out to my friends. Do I like this booklet? You bet, and I believe once you use it for your visit to the Blessed Sacrament you will be back for more writings by St Alphonsus. Also see his booklets "What Will Hell Be Like?" and "How to Converse Familiarly and Continuously with God."

St. Alphonsus Liguori's brief book is perhaps the premier devotional aid for adoration of the Blessed

Sacrament. With a guide on how to make a visit, a prayer before each visit, 31 meditations (one for each day of the month), a suggested spiritual communion, 31 intercessions to the Blessed Virgin, and a prayer to her after each visit, the book is sure to deepen the devotion and meditation of anyone who uses it. All of the prayers and meditations are brief but meaningful. The format allows repeated use, month after month, year after year, as the reader/prayer comes ever closer to Our Lord and his mother. I have used it for years, and it is continually revealing additional depths. It never grows stale. Very highly recommended.

Since I started reading this, it has become one of my most precious devotions. I cannot stop continuing the devotion anymore. I highly recommend it. It will help in increasing appreciation for the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist.
