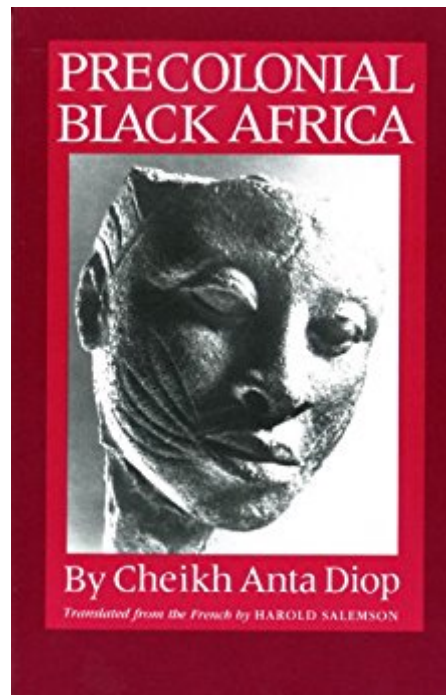




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Precolonial Black Africa

He was an early African centered scholar before the term (if not the concept) of Afrocentricity was even born. His work in African historiography has been widely acknowledged (begrudgingly by in some quarters) as being seminal and original. I wish that more American departments of African and Africana studies would give his writings a more prominent place in their curricula. Perhaps francophone institutions in Africa already do.
