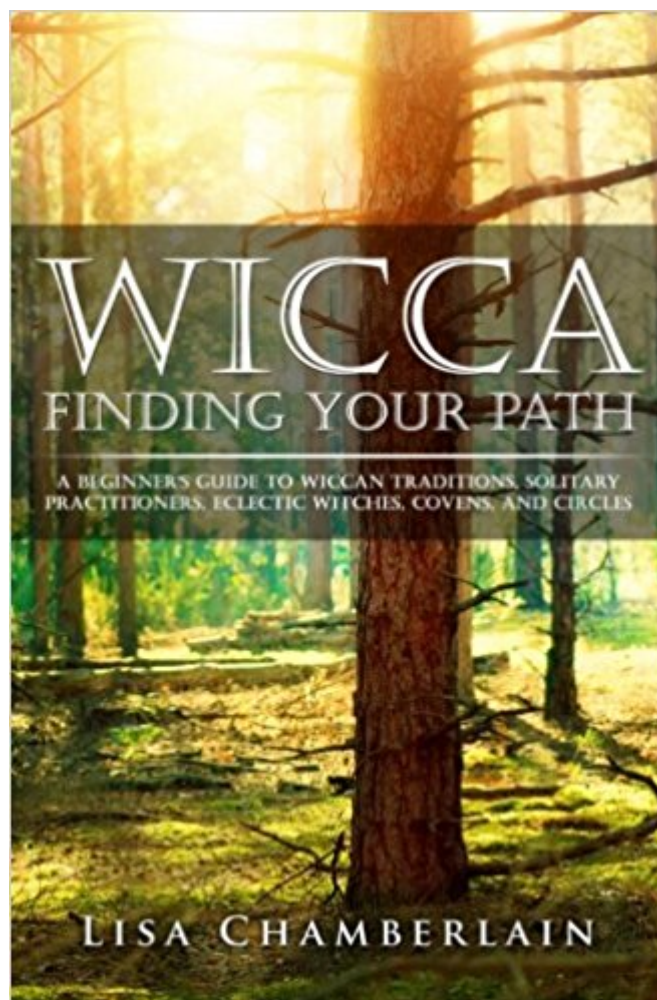

Most of the time when people say the word coven they immediately think of a group of people in black robes surrounding a cauldron. In reality, it is a spiritual community. This book provides a brief history of witchcraft and Wicca, along with a breakdown of how covens are structured. It also discusses the pros and cons of being in a coven, while also showing the possible solitary path one might choose. The author discusses the differences between Wiccan traditions while emphasizing the importance of finding your own path in your spiritual journey. A well written book that provides a solid base to begin your travels into Wicca.

Great read. Very educational in teaching the origins of Wicca and the roots of the many possible traditions to choose from. I like that the author reiterates that there's no one set path that you have to follow. Provided good insights into the various groups and some of the ups and downs of each.

This is a really fantastic book. It gives a good overview of Wicca's history without getting so engrossed in it as to lose it's main focus. Going into reading this I was somewhat unsure the book

would interest me because I do not personally have much interest in Wiccan covens. I am glad to say the opposite is true. Wicca Covens is a book that goes through a lot of material quickly and easily without ever getting bogged down by anything. It remained interesting all the way through talking about coven structure, different traditions, Eclectic Wicca, and more condensing everything down very well. The brevity was very welcome most of the time but in the area of Wiccan traditions I wish they would have had a more comprehensive list; I also think more information about forming a coven could have been included. All in all though this is a great book and I recommend it to anyone who would like to know more about Wiccan covens.
