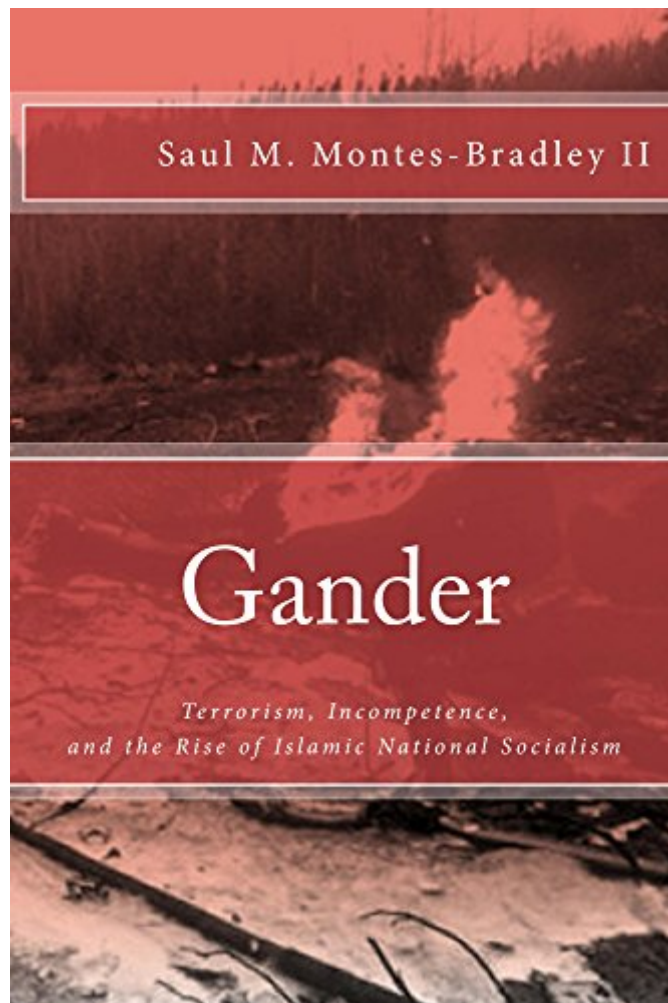




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Gander: Terrorism, Incompetence, And The Rise Of Islamic National Socialism

With courage and clinical precision, Montes-Bradley cuts through the cant of an incompetent investigation into the crash of a Military Airlift Command flight in Gander, Newfoundland, Canada. That crash killed 248 US Army personnel and eight crew on 12 December 1985. Why should we care? I care because I once flew on those flights. If I had died in such a crash, I would want my family and friends to know exactly why I died. Montes-Bradley cares because he lost his fiancée and friends in the crash. Thirty years later, he demolishes the findings of the official majority report. It wasn't icing on the wings, but a terrorist bomb, that doomed the plane. The Pan Am Flight 103

crash at Lockerbie, Scotland was not an isolated incident. That's why YOU should care. Supporters of extremist groups walk freely on our streets and shape our political world both at home and abroad. They've changed the way that we live. The first half of the book explodes the myths surrounding the Canadian Aviation Safety Board's investigation. The second half explores the origins and development of a family of movements which continue to espouse the tenets of Islamic National Socialism. Gander reveals the 'clear and present danger' we're in; a war that did not end in a bunker in Berlin.

In reading the 5-star reviews, I found them very thoughtful and accurate. I wanted to add that I was part of the crew who turned the plane over to the crew who died. My friend and I were going to stay on the plane, but one of us commented on how much scheduling hated when we did that, so decided to wait for the next week.....which never came! Additionally, another flight attendant noted that the Egyptian agents loading the flight got into a fist fight near the belly of the plane. This may have been a distraction for someone (possibly) to put an incendiary device on board. Having been there, some questions still may never be answered, but Saul's investigative writing has shed light on what was a very flawed "investigation".

This book is excellent. I learned an enormous amount and its a book to keep handy because you will go back to it again. Spread the word because after reading this theres no doubt in my mind our troops and those brave civilians were murdered by jihad and I have no doubt that our government willingly or out of stupidity or a combination of both did nothing to punish the killers. Montes-Bradley's Gander wrote an interesting and informative book about the failures to address terrorist acts. It is a grabber and I couldn't stop reading until I finished the first part in the early morning hours. The first is a thrilling investigative narrative about a great airplane disaster in Dec 1985 which killed 248 American servicemen and 8 crew members. The official investigations of the accident were outrageously poor. Montes-Bradley does his own and points out the deficiencies. The second part of the book illuminates the entire Middle East problem since the fall of the Ottoman Empire after WW II. It shows the direct influence of fascism (pictures and all) on Arab leaders and how this ideology develop until what is now, probably the biggest motivating force of warlike fanatical groups intent on conquering the world. This book is a must read for anyone interested in

learning why Moslem radicals pose a great danger to civilization.

Mr Montes-Bradley begins his book with a story of tragic personal loss. This fuels an accurate and well researched telling of the roots and growth of "radical" Islam. The tale of ignorance and collusion that allowed the hideous villains of WW2 to seed and germanate a hate that has proved to be an existential to Western Civilization. Good read. Stuff that stick.

Saul Montes-Bradley's historical narrative is a clear and dramatic chronicle of the terrible personal losses of those serving their own respective countries, caught and crushed between international and bureaucratic intrigue. Chapter 4 brought tears to my eyes and should be read only at home, not in public or at your favorite coffee shop. It is a must read for anyone of any national or political affiliation, as we all profess we hope to achieve harmony and eventual peace for this world.
