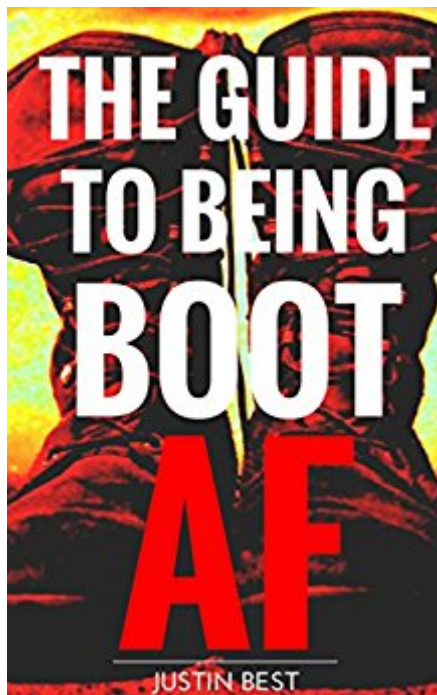

While much of the Marine history and lore wasn't applicable to my own personal experience I think that the overall arch of growth, development, trials, tribulations, obstacles, pride, disappointments and much more is relatable to anyone who has served, or is planning to serve in the elite combat arms segments regardless of the branch of military (though in my experience most Marines might dispute this claim).
