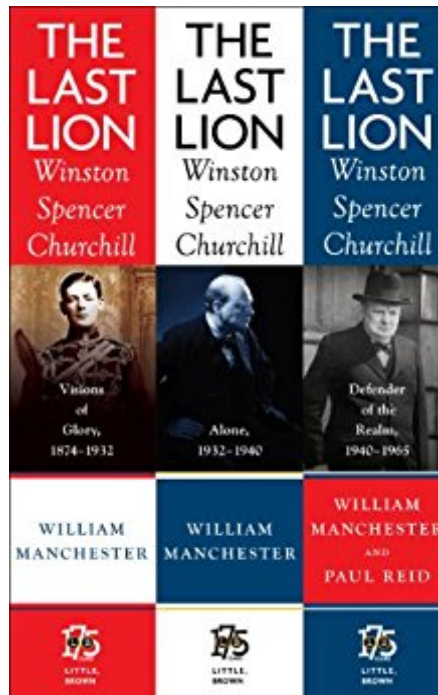


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The Last Lion Box Set: Winston Spencer Churchill, 1874 - 1965: 1,2,3
