

I read the reviews & the book sounded promising but I was completely disappointed. Maybe if you're a professional chef or love to spend the entire day making a sandwich this book is for you. For example a grilled lamb sandwich that requires 41 ingredients or a roasted cauliflower sandwich that has only 18. There is a recipe for a monte cristo that looked good until I got to the marionberry preserves & so it goes a pork shoulder with eggplant tagging that needs 31 ingredients. I don't want to give the impression that everything in the book is unappealing, it's just not anything I would ever use.

I bought this book earlier for my grown daughter; a Portlander now living in Boston, working at Harvard and she loved it. Which is something of a win to buy something your grown daughter likes. I bought this copy in error but will use it my self.
