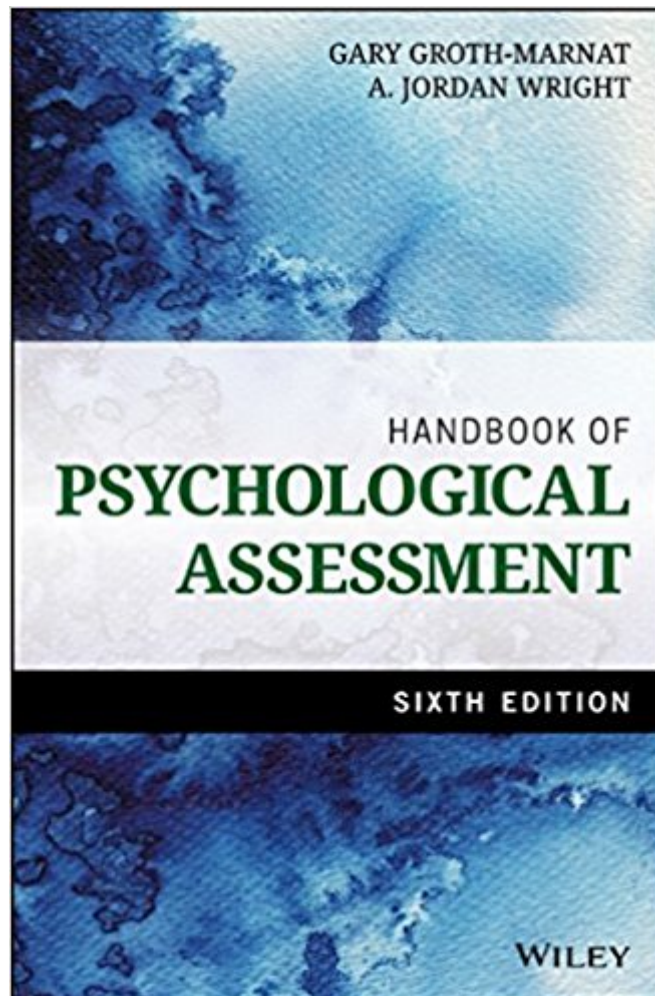




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Handbook Of Psychological Assessment

I use this book in a master's level class I teach, and I'm a bit disappointed in the new edition. The author completely cut out a valuable chapter on the TAT! So now, there is little to no information regarding any projective testing aside from the Rorschach, which is a huge part of psychological assessment (TAT, early memories, projective drawings, incomplete sentences, etc.). It's difficult to call this a "handbook" if it leaves such critical pieces of info out. Although this new edition addresses R-PAS for the Rorschach, I recommended using the 5th edition instead. Saves the students a few bucks as well.

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
