

In this instructive book, Nelms analyzes every phase of conjuring â " from sleights, devices, and illusions to misdirection, controlling the audienceâ ™s attention, incorporating â œpatter,â • and the effective use of assistants. Of particular interest is a chapter on body language, posture, positioning and movement. Also included are some 60 original routines â " from simple card tricks to such major illusions as having the performer suddenly appear at stage center. Indispensable as an instruction manual for novices, this how-to guide â " enhanced with nearly 200 of the authorâ ™s illustrations â " will also serve as a lasting source of advice and inspiration for veteran conjurers.
