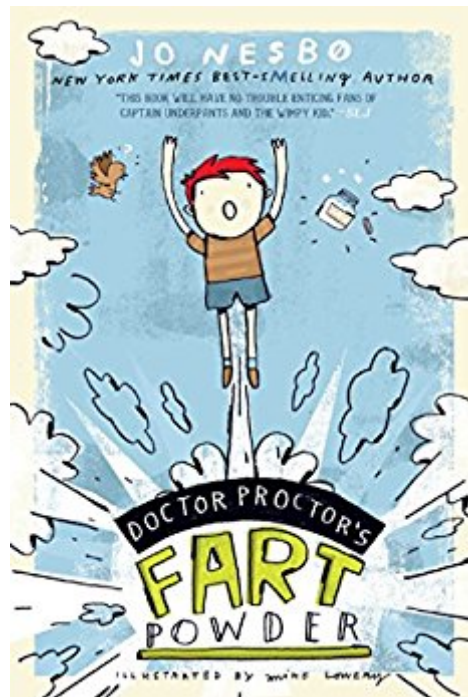

In the spirit of Roald Dahl and Lemony Snicket, Doctor Proctor offers a winning combination of humor, adventure, and absurdity that kids (of all ages) will love  proving that Jo Nesb  can keep you on the edge of the seat and make your sides split in equal measure.
