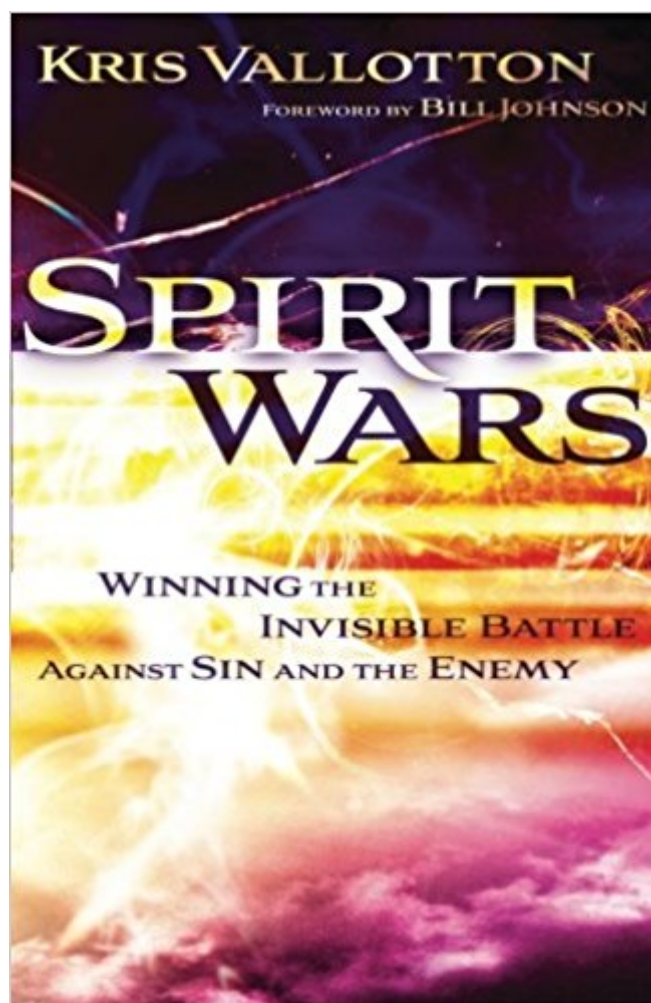

For over a year I had panic attacks. I couldn't breath, felt like I was going to die, and could never sleep more than an hour or two at a time. I would get this incredible sensation of heat and prickling on my back and shoulders all day long and then a pressure that felt like it was pushing me to the ground. I had terrible thoughts of death and suicide. At the same time, my husband was battling an illness that couldn't be diagnosed. I thought I was losing my mind. I thought if something happened to him, I'd have to find a way to end my life - and I was a Christian. I did find victory, but it would have been so much easier if I had this book to read at the time. This book helped me understand so much about myself, and about the spirit realm. I now understand the spirit world is just as real, if not more so, than this world. This is the finest work that Kris has done. The book is a must read for anyone that has gone through an attack, or even for someone who wants to better understand the spirit world and prepare to battle. I can't give enough stars (5 just isn't enough) for the insight that Kris brings by sharing his own personal experience. I HIGHLY recommend adding this amazing book to your library. "Spirit Wars" changed my life. I started reading "Spirit Wars" about a month and a half after I had been diagnosed with severe clinical depression. At the time, I had been walking with the Lord for 6 years, I had seen quite a few miracles, and I had never hit a wall like depression before. There was no family history that I was aware of, nor had I myself ever struggled with depression before. During this time I lost all my energy for anything I was passionate for; I was tormented at night with dreams, some of which were demonic in nature, some of which had accurate details about horrible situations happening around me but that I felt powerless to change. Reading "Spirit Wars" made me feel normal; it made the shame lift off my life as I realized I wasn't this awful person for dealing with depression that I seemingly couldn't shake. Hearing Kris' stories of his own dark night of the soul and how 'vision gives pain a purpose' greatly helped me; but the most insightful chapter for me was his thoughts and understanding concerning depression. Almost every chapter I read I felt as if I was reading my own story in some way, except it was written by someone who had come out on the other side. "Spirit Wars" gave me hope when I was completely hopeless. On June 6th of 2012, after a 6 month long battle with depression, I received breakthrough at my home church and I haven't had a suicidal thought since that time. I truly believe this book played a huge part in navigating and

envisioning me through one of the most difficult battles of my lifetime.

This was a very important book for me for a couple reasons:1. It was not without theology, but was also not focused to the point that it becomes an overly cerebral science.2. It uses stories and takes implications from those stories. This is important because I have found that people receive teachings on this topic and end up fighting for them to their death, and in the process they choose to disregard and deny people's experiences because it isn't supported by what they were taught. This is a bitter result to those who are struggling. Kris urges us to face the evidence that is in front of us, but not to the point that goes beyond concrete biblical concepts.3. Cares deeply for the individual who is struggling and offers them confidence and an understanding for the unpredictable situation of spiritual warfare. Many books offer ideas for overcoming a spiritual battle, but this book takes the difficult task of acknowledging that sometimes these things do not work. Most importantly Kris does this in a way that is not pessimistic or discouraging.4. The theology taught in this book is critical for building up a foundational concept of spiritual warfare.

I enjoy Kris's writing. This book is down to earth and relevant! Plenty of testimonies to flesh out the points and help the reader with life application. Thank you for Spirit Wars, a book packed with wisdom and tools for walking in Victory and helping others to as well.

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
