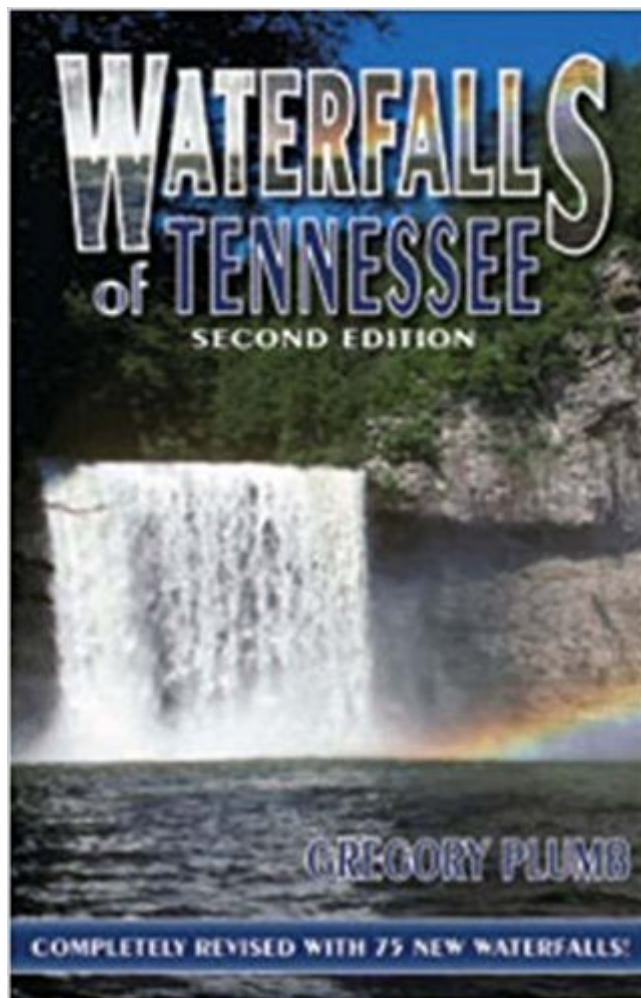

The author describes the waterfalls and the hike to them well. However, he doesn't give any landmarks so that you can find them. For instance Twin Falls, it's on the highland rim somewhere. Many of the authors now give gps coordinates or at least better directions so you have a better idea where to start looking. Take a look at Melissa Watson's books to see what I mean.
